**Introduction:** This agreement details the <u>applicability</u> of courses from the Stark State College AAS Early Childhood Education degree to the Bachelor of Science in Early Childhood Education (Birth-Age 5), Pre-K Focus ONLINE degree in the UC College of Education, Criminal Justice, and Human Services. Students who complete the AAS Early Childhood Education degree at Stark State College have partially satisfied the UC General Education requirement.

As a public institution governed by the Ohio Department of Higher Education, UC complies with the Ohio Transfer 36 (OT36) and the Transfer Assurance Guides (TAGs). As a public institution governed by the Ohio Department of Higher Education, Stark State College complies with the Ohio Transfer 36 (OT36) and the Transfer Assurance Guides (TAGs).

**Articulation Overview:** Graduates from Stark State College who have followed the prescribed program and are accepted into the UC College of Education, Criminal Justice, and Human Services will enter with 63 hours of transfer credit applicable toward the Bachelor of Science in Early Childhood Education (Birth-Age 5), Pre-K Focus ONLINE degree.

Stark State College warrants that it is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission. The College will notify University of Cincinnati if such accreditation ceases to exist. University of Cincinnati warrants that it is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission. University of Cincinnati will notify Stark State College if such accreditation ceases to exist.

Appropriate publications and promotional materials regarding this agreement will be made available to Stark State College students.

**Admission Criteria:** Please note: completing the courses on the worksheet below does not guarantee admission to the UC Bachelor of Science in Early Childhood Education (Birth-Age 5), Pre-K Focus ONLINE degree program.

Minimum GPA: 2.50

**BS Completion**: Completion of this program may require more than four semesters to complete due to prerequisite requirements and the order in which required courses must be taken and are offered. UC academic advising staff will work with each transfer student to develop the most expedient pathway to graduation

**Admission Period**: Stark State College students must be admitted to the UC College of Education, Early Childhood Education, and Human Services during the duration of this agreement (i.e. between August 2022 and August 2025).

**Agreement Execution Date**: August 2022 **Agreement End Date**: August 2025

#### **EXECUTION, DURATION AND REVIEW OF AGREEMENT:**

This agreement becomes effective upon its signing by the Deans of both Colleges and will remain effective for three years. At the end of this time, the agreement will be reviewed and may be renegotiated. Stark State College and the UC College of Education, Criminal Justice, and Human Services agree to keep one another informed as program changes affecting the agreement occur. The Deans of both Colleges will agree upon any future additions and/or amendments to this document in writing.

This agreement will be reviewed on an annual basis and is subject to change due to revisions in program curriculum.

# TRANSFER ARTICULATION AGREEMENT



As strong partners, Stark State College Early Childhood program agrees to provide direct access to students in the last semester of their degree program to a University of Cincinnati representative. This could be in the form of a classroom visit or other opportunities to directly interact and educate students about the program at the University of Cincinnati. Stark State College Early Childhood Education program also agrees to provide a graduation list with email addresses. The University of Cincinnati College of Education, Criminal Justice, and Human Services will provide success rates of incoming cohorts of Stark State College Early Childhood Education students upon request.
