
Start-to-Graduation Support

Careers in Communication

The Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS) projects employment of media and communications occupations to grow 14 percent from 2022 to 2032, faster than the average for all occupations, and will result in about 114,300 job openings each year.

The median annual wage for media and communication workers (such as public relations specialists, news analysts, and writers and authors) was \$66,240 in May 2022, which was higher than the median annual wage for all occupations of \$46,310.







How are classes formatted?

Classes are online and asynchronous. You will have weekly assignments with due dates, but you may log on at any time 24/7 to complete your coursework. To enhance your experience and learning, many of our instructors offer online office hours held at a predetermined date and time.



Can I transfer credit hours from my previous institution?

Yes. You will need to work with a program advisor to understand what credits will apply and meet requirements at the University of Cincinnati.

If I live in Cincinnati, can I still come to campus if I'm an online student?

Yes, you may attend on-campus classes if you are an online student.
