QM emphasizes a collegial and collaborative review process, involving faculty with recent online teaching experience or instruction designers specializing in online course development.





Admissions Requirements

For high school students:

Official high school transcripts with a minimum GPA of 2.7 (unweighted) or 2.9 (weighted).



- Students that have not completed at least 24 semester (36 quarter) college credit hours:
 - 1. Official high school transcripts with a minimum GPA of 2.7 (unweighted) or 2.9 (weighted) and,
 - 2. Official transcripts from all institutions of higher education with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 (all prior institutions combined).
- Students that have completed at least 24 semester (36 quarter) college credit hours:
 - 1. Official transcripts from all institutions of higher education with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 (all prior institutions combined).


Required Application Documents:

- No test scores required
- The online application fee is waived through Summer 2025
- Send official high school and college transcripts to UC Office of Admissions






